### **MaineGeneral's Workplace Health plans occupational health clinic in Winthrop**

MaineGeneral Health is opening an occupational health services clinic at the Winthrop Commerce Center downtown in September.

"Area employers will have convenient access to specialized medical care for their employees who have been injured or become ill on the job," said Denise Dumont-Bernier, director of Workplace Health. "It will mean less travel, less time away from work and more cost-effective care."

Laboratory and X-ray services also are available at the Center and occupational and physical therapy services are located nearby at MaineGeneral's Manchester facility.
