Medication Collection Day Sept. 25 slated for towns throughout Kennebec Valley

The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has scheduled a Medication Collection Day for unused, unwanted or expired medications from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on **Saturday, Sept. 25.**

Area residents are encouraged to bring their unused, unwanted or outdated personal or veterinarian medications (no needles, lancets or syringes) to any of the following locations. Medication collection is for individual households only, not for health care facilities.

- Augusta Police Station – 33 Union Street
- Belgrade Community Center – 1 Center Drive (Rt. 27)
- China Transfer Station – 191 Alder Park Road
- Fairfield Police Station – 75 Water Street
- Monmouth Town Office – 859 Main Street
- Oakland Police Department – 7 Fairfield Street
- Readfield/Wayne Transfer Station – North Road, Readfield
- Waterville Police Station – Common Street
- West Gardiner Fire Department – 318 Spears Corner Road
- Winslow Police will collect door-to-door: Call 872-5215 weekdays, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., to plan pick-up
- Winthrop Transfer Station – Route 202

In addition, residents may drop off medications on Sept. 25, from 8 a.m. to noon at:

- Kennebec Valley YMCA – 40 Granite Hill Road, Manchester
