## MaineGeneral Hospice

MaineGeneral Hospice helps those with life-limiting illnesses live as comfortably and fully as possible. We focus on the quality of your life.

We respect your wish to die with dignity, surrounded by those you love. Our goal is to give you and your family peace, comfort and caring when you need it most. Most importantly, you are in control of your care.

### Eligibility

Hospice care is provided to a person of any age who is facing a life-limiting illness, such as cancer, or a non-cancer disease, such as the latter stages of lung or cardiac disease, dementia, renal failure or a combination of diseases that, together, are life-limiting.

If you are not seeking a cure but want appropriate pain and symptom management for comfort, we can help.

To be eligible for Hospice, if you have Medicare Part A or MaineCare, your care provider must indicate that you have a prognosis of six months, if your disease follows its usual course.

Many private insurance companies cover Hospice care if your care provider indicates you have a prognosis of 12 months.

- Volunteer services are free.
- We provide needed services regardless of ability to pay.
- You can receive care wherever you live — your home, a nursing or residential care facility, hospital or a loved one's home.
